You may be eligible for the Commodity Supplemental Food Program!

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) is a once a month food distribution for individuals **60 years of age** or older.

Eligibility is determined by age, residence (**Peabody residence only**), gross monthly income and household size – please see the chart below.

CSFP Income Guidelines (Effective 2/2026)			
Household Size*	Weekly	Monthly	Annually
1	\$461	\$1,995	\$23,940
2	\$625	\$2,705	\$32,460
3	\$789	\$3,415	\$40,980
4	\$952	\$4,125	\$49,500
