Our Mission

- To promote social connection: Friendly phone calls help build meaningful connections between trained callers and older adults.
- To conduct a wellness check-in: WeCare callers check to make sure our older adults are doing well and are not in immediate harm or in need of urgent medical attention.

Who is eligible

- The service is free of charge and available to older adults who: are 60 years of age or older; live alone or are homebound; and reside in Beverly, Danvers, Nahant, Marblehead, Peabody, Salem, or Swampscott. Individuals can self-refer or be referred by a caregiver.
