What? Wills, healthcare proxy, durable power of attorney, and basic deed drafting. Family law consultation on: custody, child support and alimony.

How does it work? Call Veterans Services at the number listed below to schedule an appointment with a volunteer attorney. Services may take more than one appointment to complete. All services are to be provided at the Torigian Community Life Center. Volunteer attorneys will not take any money or compensation of any kind from Veterans for their services/consultation and will refer out Veterans needing further services/consultation. If a Veteran needs representation beyond those provided at the Torigian Community Life Center, a referral list of trusted attorneys has been established from which veterans can select an attorney to contact and hire.
