

Our sense of hearing is very important for participating fully in life. Hearing keeps us connected to those we love. Untreated hearing loss can lead to social isolation, depression and poor health. Well fit hearing aids are known to improve quality of life and may prevent memory and cognitive decline by keeping people engaged and stimulating the hearing and language areas of the brain.

Hearing aids are a medical necessity but are not covered by most health insurance. The North Shore Hearing

Foundation provides hearing aids to people of very low income, up to 250% of the federal poverty level. There is a co-pay of up to \$250 that goes back to the Foundation to help the next person. Residents of Lynn, Nahant, Swampscott, Marblehead, Salem and Peabody apply through their Council on Aging to determine financial eligibility. Professional services are donated by the staff of Atlantic Hearing Care and are provided by appointment at their offices in Swampscott or Peabody.
